**CUSTODIAL AND
NON-CUSTODIAL PARENT INFORMATION**

Non-custodial parents have the right to information about their children unless we have a copy of a court decree specifying otherwise. The law generally allows students and/or students' records to be released to either parent, to both parents or to legal guardians. We do mail copies of report cards to a non-custodial parent unless there is a court decree prohibiting this.

In general, it is the responsibility of the custodial parent to keep the non-custodial parent informed of school events involving the children.

Please attach a copy of any court decree prohibiting access to your child/ren or information about his/her progress if you have not already filed one with the school.
